
Subject: Permanent absorption in BSNL- case of Shri Ram Autar Gautam, JTO (Retd.), Rajasthan Telecom Circle

Sir,

I am directed to refer to letter No. BSNL/11/SR/2003(30) dated 03.07.2019 on the subject noted above and to convey the approval of competent authority for **permanent absorption of Shri Ram Autar Gautam, JTO (BSNL Optee)**, HRMS No. 198705740, Rajasthan Circle in BSNL w.e.f 01.10.2000 subject to outcome of criminal appeal (CRLLA-56/2016) preferred by ACB, which is pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Jodhpur against his acquittal vide judgement dated 29.10.2015. No disciplinary case is pending against him as per records of this Department. The Vigilance clearance has been granted to him subject to outcome of above-mentioned criminal appeal.

2. The Order of absorption of above-mentioned officer may be issued by the Director (Estt.) nominated at the Rajasthan Circle. While issuing Presidential order, it may be specifically mentioned and communicated that the absorption will be without prejudice to the action that may be taken by Department of Telecom if the judgement of Trial Court acquitting him is set aside. In case, the above-mentioned employee is convicted in Criminal Appeal/Review etc, the presidential order and consequential benefits shall be deemed *not est and he shall stand reverted and action would be taken against him under Rule 19 of CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 read with Rule 9 of CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972. Provisions of Rule 69 of CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972 would still apply to the above-mentioned officer until outcome of judicial proceedings.* An undertaking in this regard may be obtained from the above-mentioned officer before issuing his order of absorption.
