**Sir,**


I am directed to refer the subject mentioned above and to state that as per ITS RRs 1992, para 10 (4): *'During the period of probation or any extension thereof, the officers may be required to undergo such training and instructions and to pass such examination and tests (including examination in Hindi) as prescribed by the controlling authority from time to time.'*

2. Hon'ble Supreme Court, in its judgment dated 08.07.2010 has viewed that *"while there is some necessity for appointing a person in Govt. service on probation for a particular period, there may not be any need for confirmation of the officer after completion of the probation period. If during the period, a Govt. servant is found to be unsuitable, his/her services may be terminated..."* thereby implying that completion of probation eventually leads to deemed confirmation.

3. It is therefore, requested that the Professional Examination and Hindi Tests of ADEsT of ITS Group 'A' 2012 batch and all the batches onward should be conducted as soon as training (including on job attachments) gets completed as per training schedule.
