

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject- **Nomination of Civilian/Para Military Officers for training in the 72nd Staff Course at Defence Services Staff College (DSSC), Wellington, Commencing from 06 June, 2016.**

DIR (Tg)

The undersigned is directed to say that the Defence Service Staff College (DSSC), Wellington, conducts 45 weeks course (which does not include the Orientation Capsule which is of three weeks) for officers of the three Defence Services of the rank of Captains/Majors in the Army and their equivalent in other Services. The course lays stress on issues relating to Inter-Services co-operation and planning.

2. The 72nd Staff Course is scheduled to commence from 06th June, 2016 to 15th April, 2017. Four vacancies are earmarked in this course for **Group 'A' Officers of Central Civil Services**. The selected Officers will be required to undergo an Orientation Course of 03 weeks commencing from **16th May, 2016 to 04th June, 2016**. Dates of reporting for the Orientation Course (for Foreign and Civilian Officers) and the Main Course at DSSC are **14th May, 2016 and 23rd May, 2016** respectively. Per capita cost of training for this course will be applicable as per rates existing at present. Only those officers should be sponsored who can be assuredly released from **May, 2016 till April, 2017** for attending the course, if selected.

3. It is requested that nominations of the willing Officers belonging to the requisite Service along with particulars of Officers and their up-to-date CR Dossiers for the last five years as per Annexures II & III (enclosed herewith) respectively may be sent to this Ministry so as to reach the undersigned latest by **15th January, 2016 positively**. **Annexures IV and V are also being enclosed concerning nomination of civilian/para military officers.** It will not be possible to consider nominations which are received after this date.
