Overview

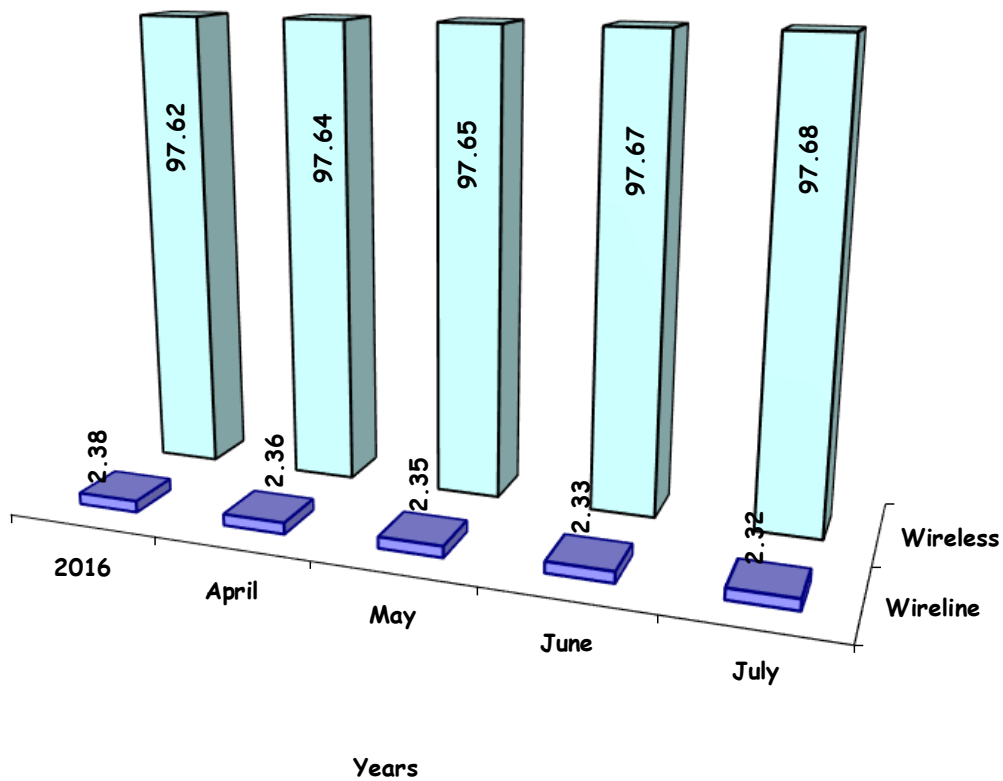
- ☞ At the end of July'16, for which the latest data are available, the total number of telephones was 10594.30 lakh, as compared to 10602.79 lakh by the end of June'16 i.e., a decrease of 8.49 lakh.
- ☞ By the end of July'16, the share of wireless segment was 97.68%. The share of wireline telephones has been steadily declining and is now reported at 2.32%, it was 2.33% in June'16.
- ☞ The public sector's share has increased further to 10.61%, while that of the private sector has decreased to 89.39%.
- ☞ In the month of July'16, the share of rural areas in total telephone subscriptions is 42.15% against 42.51% of June'16. The share of urban areas increased and stands at 57.85% against 57.49% of June'16.
- ☞ The telecom Service area-wise analysis reveals that Uttar Pradesh - [East] has the highest share in the total telephones, followed by Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Bihar and Andhra Pradesh. Their shares in the total telephones being 8.95%, 8.13%, 7.87%, 7.18% and 7.11%, respectively. These five Service areas taken together have a share of 39.24% in the total telephone connections in India.
- ☞ The overall tele-density at the end of July'16 was 83.09%. Rural and urban tele-density was 50.99% and 153.53% respectively. Among the Service areas, Himachal Pradesh (129.39%) has the highest tele-density followed by Tamil Nadu (117.12%), Punjab (106.66%), Kerala (103.49%) and Karnataka (101.44%). Among the three metros, Delhi Service Area tops in tele-density with 234.77 % tele-density, followed by Kolkata (164.91%) and Mumbai (147.88%).
- ☞ The number of Internet subscribers (both broadband and narrowband put together) which was 3023.50 lakh at the end of March, 2015 increased to 3426.50 lakh by the end of March, 2016. The number of subscribers accessing internet via wireless phones etc. was 3222.10 lakh at the end of March, 2016. The number of wired Internet subscribers was 204.40 lakh at the end of March, 2016. The number of Broadband subscribers was 1669.60 lakh at the end of July'16.

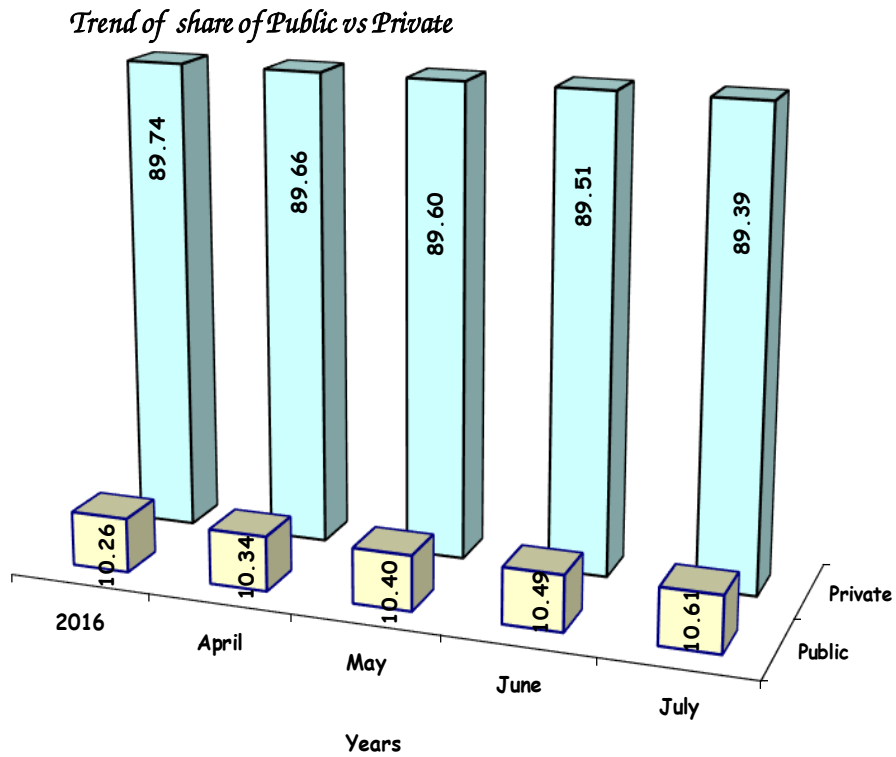

Trend of share of Wireline vs Wireless



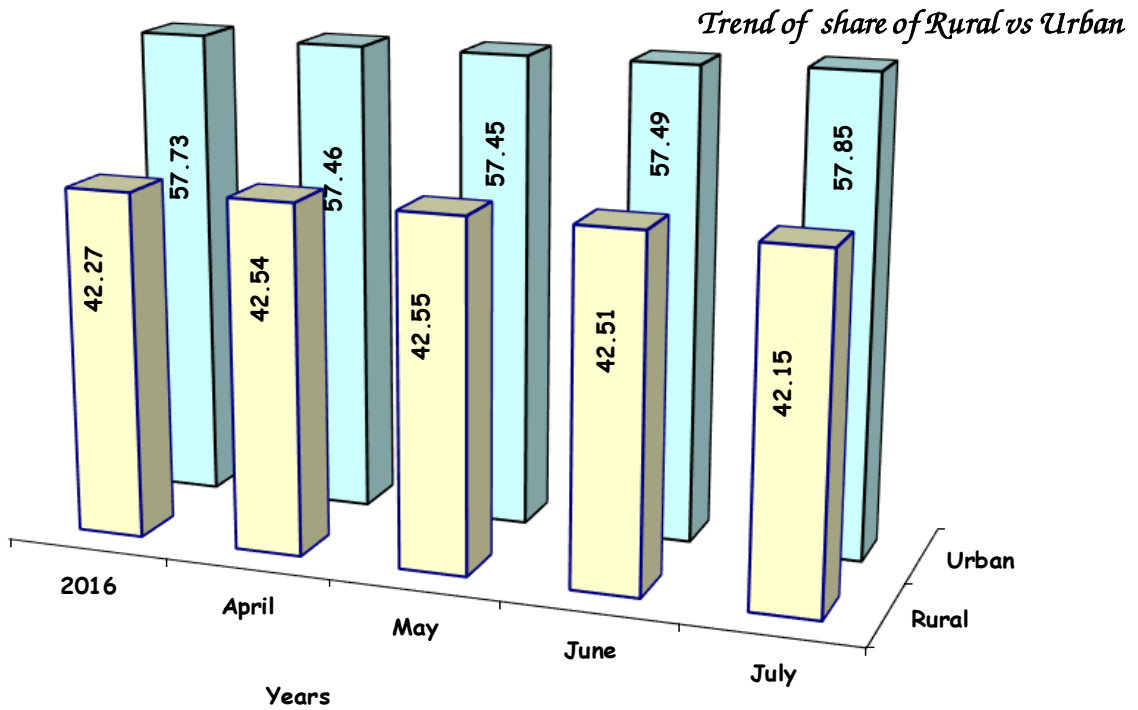

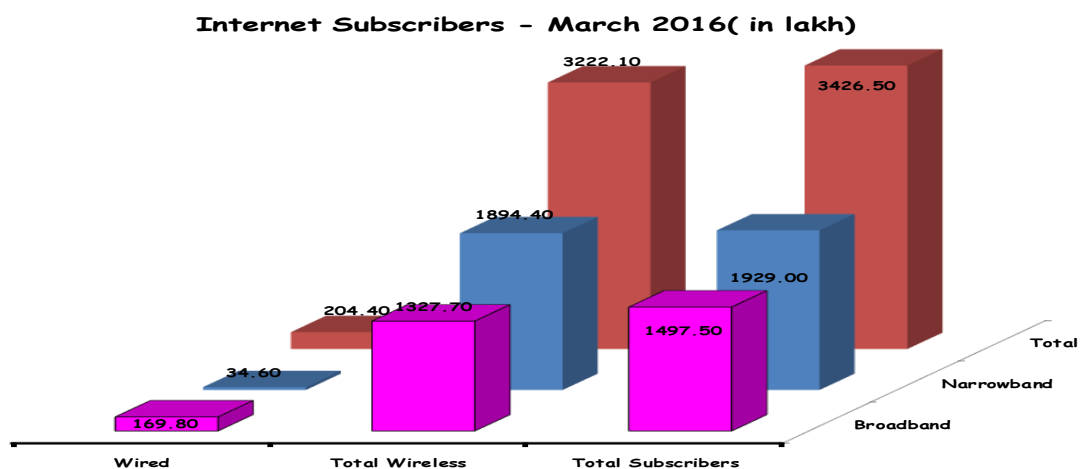
