The undersigned is directed to say that the Defence Service Staff College (DSSC), Wellington, conducts 45 weeks course (which does not include the Orientation Capsule which is of three weeks) for officers of the three Defence Services of the rank of Captains/Majors in the Army and their equivalent in other Services.
