Dear *Shri R Chandra Sekhar,*

With reference to your letter no dated 400-49/20123-STG III dated 15<sup>th</sup> November 12 on consideration the appointment of ITS officers on deputation basis in the area, e-governance, SWAN, Project implementation evaluation and monitoring, Budgeting, Policy formulation, Project Planning etc, Maharashtra being a leading State using IT platform for delivery of various services certainly requires officers having expertise in these areas.

At the outset, IT department has assessed its present requirement and we immediately require 1 SAG and 2 JAG officer at Mahaonline and one SAG and 2 JAG rank officers in Setu Society. In JAG category, a mix of names may please be sent to us, including some selection grade officers.

In Government of Maharashtra various e-governance projects and mission mode projects are being undertaken by IT department through Setu Society as a state designated agency which is established society act under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary. It is responsible for projects like State Wide Area Network, State Data centre, UID etc. 'Mahaonline' is a joint venture between Government of Maharashtra and TCS under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary.

Salary of the officers would be given as per Central Government. However, certain allowances like children education allowance, travel by business class etc. are not being given in the state, even to IAS officers, and hence for such perks, State Government Rules will apply. Also, Govt. of Maharashtra would not provide any accommodation to these officers; they have to make their own arrangement. HRA as admissible would be given to them.

The officers having experience of maintaining data Centre, leased lines, networking, e-governance would be preferred. You are requested to send a panel of 10 officers against SAG level and 20 officers against the JAG (mix of Selection Grade and juniors) level to us for further evaluation and selection.

I have already instructed Principal Secretary General Administration Department to assess the requirement at various level in other departments and that proposal would be sent to you separately.
