- 2. CGHS facilities were extended to retired BSNL/MTNL employees who are in receipt of pension from Central Civil Estimates vide Department of Telecommunications OM No. 4-12(11)/2012-PAT(Part) dated 31.08.2016 and OM No. 4-12(11)/2012-PAT(Part) dated 18.10.2016. The matter has been examined in the light of above orders and it is clear that CGHS facilities were extended only to the retired BSNL/MTNL employees who are in receipt of pension from Central Civil Estimates.
- 3. In view of the above, it is clarified that facilities mentioned in Ministry of Health & Family Welfare OM dated 29.09.2016 are applicable only to those retired BSNL/MTNL employees who are in receipt of pension from Central Civil Estimates.

#### OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub:-Reimbursement of medical claims to pensioners under CS (MA) Rules, 1944 as directed by various CATs/Courts - Regarding.

The undersigned is directed to state that various references are being received in Ministry of Health and family Welfare on the above mentioned subject. It is hereby clarified that CS (MA) Rules, 1944 are not applicable to pensioners till date.

It is further informed that the following options to avail medical facilities are available to Central Government pensioners:

## a) Pensioners residing In CGHS covered areas:

- 1) They can get themselves registered in CGHS dispensary after making requisite contribution and can avail both OPD and IPD facilities.
- 2) Pensioners residing in CGHS areas cannot opt out of CGHS and avail any other medical facility (i.e. Fixed Medical Allowance). Such pensioners, if they do not choose to avail CGHS facility by depositing the required contributions, cannot be granted Fixed Medical allowance in lieu of CGHS.

## b) Pensioners residing in non-CGHS areas:

- 1) They can avail Fixed Medical Allowance (FMA) @ Rs.500/- per month.
- 2) They can also avail benefits of CGHS (OPD and IPD) by registering themselves in the nearest CGHS city after making the required subscription.
- 3) They also have the option to avail FMA, for OPD treatment and CGHS for IPD treatments after making the required subscriptions as per CGHS guidelines.
- In view of the above, reimbursement of medical claims to pensioners under CS (MA) Rules, 1944 as directed by various CATs/Courts, need not be referred to the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. The respective Administrative Department/Ministry may take their own decision in this
- further, all Departments/Ministries are requested to intimate their employees proceeding for retirement regarding the above options for medical facilities available to the Central Government



Extension of the CGHS facilities to the retired BSNL/MTNL employees who are in receipt of pension from Central Civil Estimates- criteria for determining Grade Pay and Ward entitlement regarding.

The issue of extension of the CGHS facilities to the retired BSNL/MTNL employees who are in receipt of pension from Central Civil Estimates has been under consideration in this department with consultation of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoH&FW). It has been decided that Pension Payment Order issued to the pensioners getting pension from Central Civil Estimates will also mention the equivalent basic pay and grade pay as per the Central Pay Scale. This will enable CGHS in deciding rate of contribution and ward entitlement for issue of CGHS cards.

- 2. The corresponding mapping of Pay & Scales from IDA to CDA is enclosed in the Annexure for deciding the contribution and entitlement.
- 3. This issues with the approval of DDG (Estt.), Department of Telecom.
