NOTIFICATION

1. I, ^{SG} in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 509 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Wireless Planning and Coordination and Monitoring Organisation (Technical Officers and Staff) Recruitment Rules, 1960 and Wireless Planning and Coordination and Monitoring Organisation (Technical Officers and Staff) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules 1990, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Wireless Adviser/Engineer-in-Charge in the Wireless Planning and Coordination Wing and Wireless Monitoring Organisation, namely: -

1. **Short title and commencement.** - (1) These rules may be called the Wireless Planning and Coordination and Monitoring Organisation (Assistant Wireless Adviser/Engineer-in-Charge) Recruitment Rules, 2003.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.** - The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule, annexed hereto.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.** :- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualifications.** - No person, -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax: - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.


Note: The Departmental offices in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note: Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organisation, Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
