The licensees shall comply with the Guidance for Enhanced Supervision and Effective Control of Telecommunication Networks, as per guidelines to be issued Networks, as per guidelines to be issued by the licensor.

With effect from 15th June 2021, the permission from Designated Authority for Equipment not designated as Trusted Contracts (AMC) or updates to existing as on date of effect.

The licensees shall comply with the Guidance for Enhanced Supervision and Effective Control of Telecommunication by the licensor.

This amendment shall be part and parcel of the INSAT MSS-R Services License 2. Agreement and all others Terms & Conditions shall remain unchanged.
