Sub:- Requisition of Officers for deployment as Expenditure Observers in forthcoming Assembly Elections/Bye-elections-Regarding.

Sir.

As you are aware that the terms of Legislative Assemblies of Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Meghalaya and Tripura are due to expire in the month of January/February/March, 2023. Apart from these, a number of Bye-elections to PCs/ACs may held in various States/UTs in coming months. Deployment of Expenditure Observers for close observation of process of elections at the constituency level has become an integral part of election management in order to check the abuse of money power during elections. As micro management is now a proven methodology, the role of Expenditure Observers for ensuring free and fair election in the country has become extremely important in recent times.

After careful consideration of all aspects, the Election Commission of India has decided to requisition 10 IP&TAFS officers. While recommending 10 IP&TAFS officers, the Department of Telecommunication, M/o Communication is requested to keep the following points in view:-

- The names of the officers who are on long leave, who are on long term training, within
 the country or overseas, or who are having a medical condition which prevents them
 from doing field election duty during this period are not to be considered for
 nomination.
- 2) The names of the officers who have less than 3 years for retirement or who had earlier been removed by the Commission from various election related duties and against whom Election Commission has recommended disciplinary action or those against whom any criminal case is pending in any court of law should not be sponsored.
- Officers falling within allotment year 2005 to 2014 may only be considered for nomination.

The information in enclosed proforma from your department may be sent in hard as well as soft copy for the Commission's consideration and decision latest by 20th August, 2022. Any change in the contact/posting details of the officers sponsored may be informed to the Commission.

The Election Commission further desires that a nodal officer may be appointed by the Department of Telecommunication, M/o Communication for co-ordinating the flow of information and other aspects of deployment of Expenditure Observers and the nodal officer's name, designation, mobile number, office phone number, fax number and e-mail ID may be communicated to the Election Commission of India at the earliest.
