Subject: Clarification i.r.t. Import of license-free wireless equipment- matter reg.

Sir.

Representation(s) has been received from the importer(s) of wireless equipment operating in the license-exempted frequency bands stating that Customs Authority is seeking Import license as issued by WPC Wing, DoT for import of such products; whereas, vide order dated 26.02.2019 (copy attached), such products, complying with the said order, are permitted to be imported based on an undertaking to be submitted to Customs Authority (generated from Saralsanchar).

- 2. In this regard it is intimated that a letter was issued from WPC Wing vide No. P-11014/04/2013-PP (Vol-I) dated 12.07.2021, requesting Customs authority to strictly enforce the provision of DGFT Import policy i.r.t. import of wireless equipment. However, it was not in suppression of any other order issued earlier from WPC Wing on the subject. Hence, any exemption from import licensing requirement from WPC Wing, granted earlier vide any order/ O.M. will continue to be applicable.
- 3. It is clarified that vide order dated 26.02.2019, the process of obtaining ETA certificate and subsequent import license was made simpler by making it under self-declaration mode. Under this, for any product complying with the Gazette Notifications w.r.t. license-exempt frequency use and falling under 'FREE' category of DGFT Import policy, ETA certificate could be obtained under self-declaration (from Saralsanchar portal) by fulfilling other procedural formalities. Import clearance of such products could be obtained by submitting an undertaking (generated from Saralsanchar) to the Customs authority along with the ETA Certificate (Please refer order dated 26.02.2019 for details). For such cases, no separate import license is required from WPC Wing

Subject: ETA through self-declaration for certain categories of Wireless Equipment in license exempt bands.

This is with reference to Equipment Type Approval (ETA) requirement for certain categories of wireless equipment operating in license exempt bands with low transmission power which are exempted from import licensing requirement as per the import policy of DGFT.

- 2. ETA through self-declaration is permitted for commercial / finished products such as mobile / computing devices viz. as mobile handsets, smart phones, electronic notepads, laptops, Smart watches, Short Range Devices including accessories, microphones, speakers, headphones, earphones, printers, scanners, cameras etc., operating in licensed exemption bands as permitted in India. A self-declaration from importer / authorized Indian representative may be treated as sufficient evidence to process such clearances by the Customs and Central Excise Authorities. (self-declaration format is enclosed).
- 3. Import license requirements are as regulated by the Export and Import (EXIM) Policy of DGFT.
