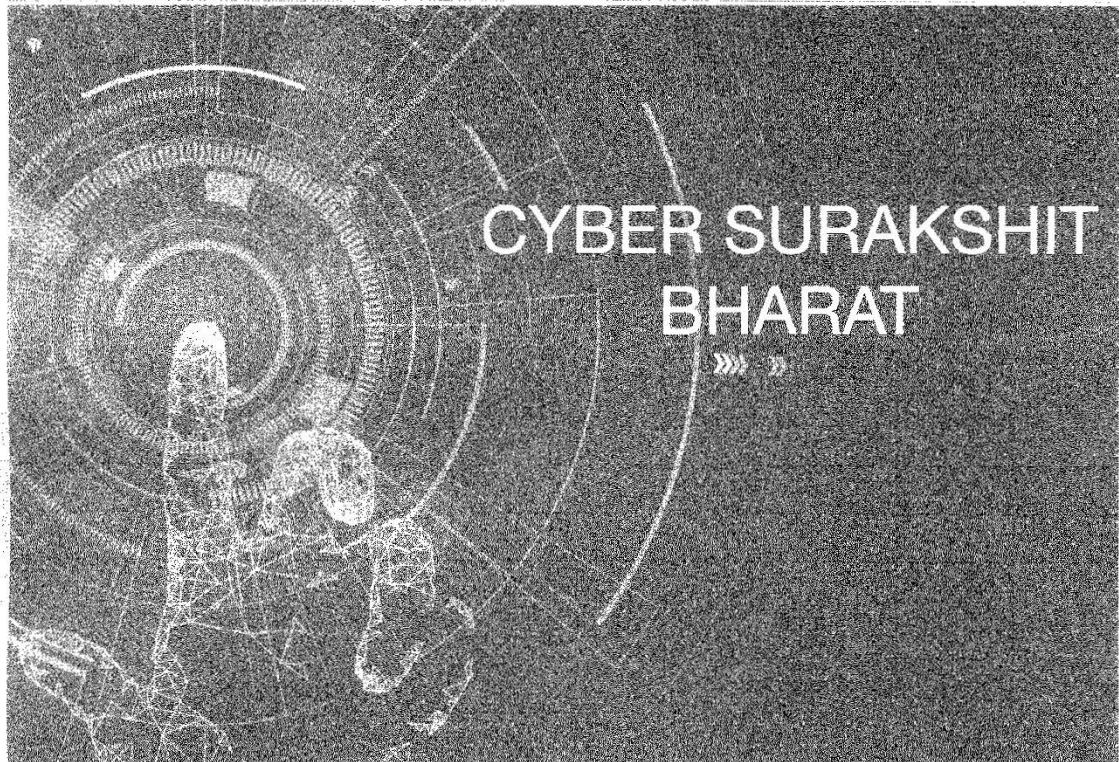

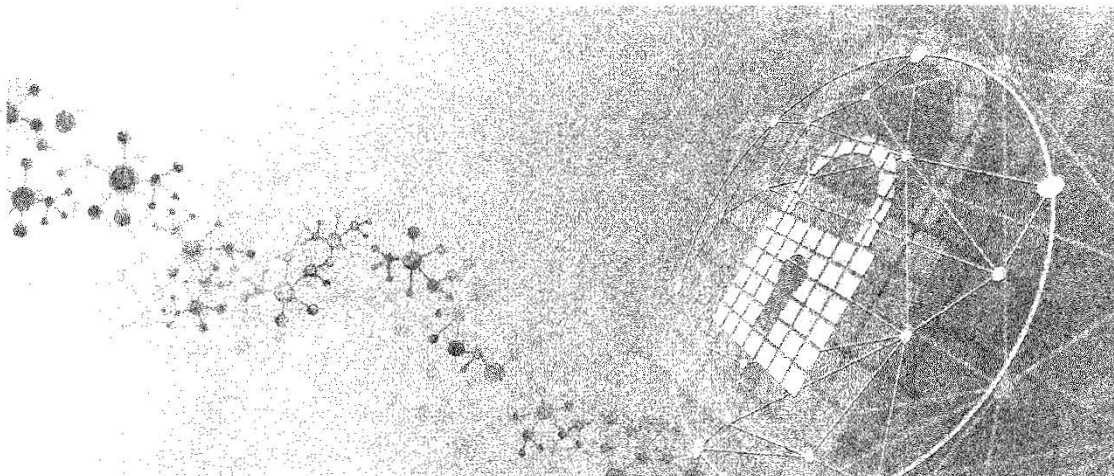

**Spouse/family guest will not be allowed to accompany the participant during any part of the training programme.


NOMINATION PROCESS

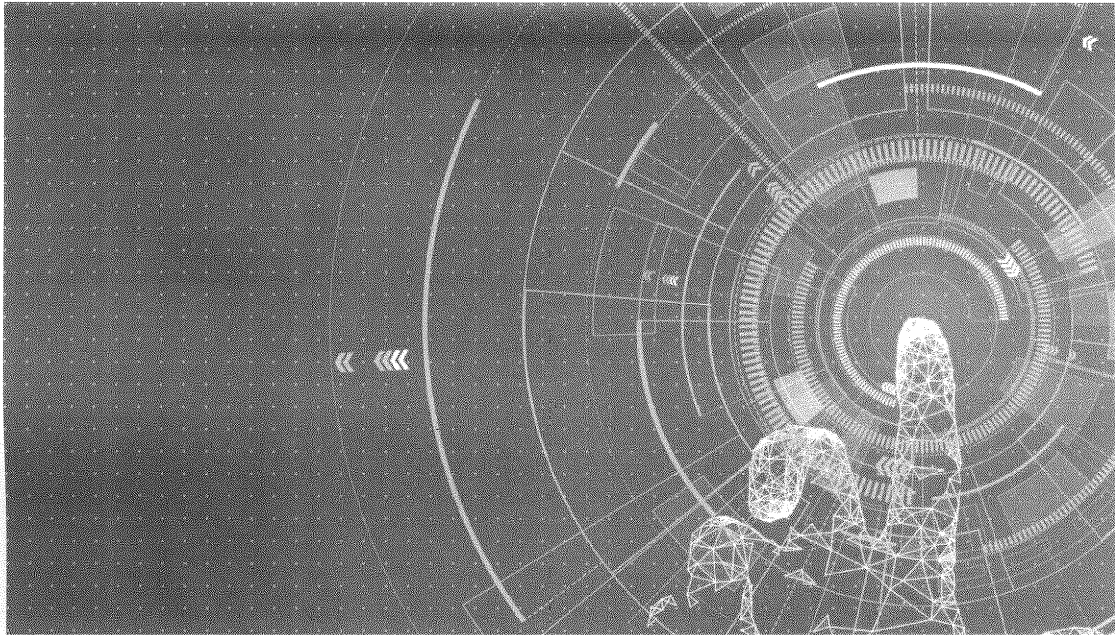
