**Subject: Compliance of DOT letter No. 8520-01/98-LR/Vol.(IX) Pt. I dated 16.11.21 regarding revised IPDR parameters.**

Reference: (i) DOT letter No. 8520-01/98-LR/Vol. (IX) Pt. I dated 16.11.21  
(ii) COAI / ISPAI / ACTO Letter No. JTL / 2022/002 dated 25.10.2022

This is with reference to the DOT letter dated 16.11.21 under reference (i) above regarding revised IPDR parameters and representation on the same under reference (ii) above requesting for some more time and extend the deadline to at least 31.3.23 for implementation of DOT Instructions under reference (i) above.

2. In above reference, the undersigned has been directed to intimate as follows:

- (i) Last extension of 3 months is granted to All Licensees with Internet Service Authorization to comply with DOT instructions under reference (i) above i.e. from 31.10.22 to 31.01.23. **Please note that no further extension will be granted.**
- (ii) All remaining Licensees who have not intimated compliance till date to the respective LSAs, are required to:
  - (a) Intimate progress of compliance of DOT instructions under reference (i) above, to each of their respective LSAs in which they are providing service, every month, latest by 20<sup>th</sup> November 2022, 16<sup>th</sup> December 2022 and 16<sup>th</sup> January 2023.
  - (b) Intimate their compliance of the DOT instructions under reference (i) above, in all respects for each LSA where they are providing Service, to respective LSAs **latest by 31.01.23**, without fail, in reference to Unified License Clause 10 of Chapter I and Clause 39.20 of Chapter-VI / Clause 10 and Clause 34.23 of Internet Service License 2007.  
Note: All respects means each of the parameters of the DOT instructions under reference (i) above should be available i.r.o 100% of IPV4 and IPV6 IPDRs.

3. Each LSA is required to review status and progress of ISPs/ TSPs w.r.t. DOT instructions under reference (i) above and send report to the undersigned in the format attached, every month latest by 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2022, 20<sup>th</sup> December 2022 and 20<sup>th</sup> January 2023.
