

I am very pleased to inform you that the International Telecommunication Union is organizing a training workshop on "IPv6 Migration Strategy for Telecom Service Providers" under the framework of ITU Asia Pacific Centres of Excellence (ITU ASP CoE). This training is being jointly organized with the Ministry of Information and Communication Technology (MICT), Thailand in partnership with APNIC and other organisations. This training will be held at TOT Academy, Bangkok, from 25 to 28 July 2011 followed by the ITU Asia-Pacific Centres of Excellence Management Committee Meeting on 29 July 2011.

This Training Workshop (25-28 July), which is targeted at Telecom Service Providers, Policy Makers, Regulators, Technical Experts, Academic Researcher, aims to build skill on developing a migration strategy from a telecommunication service provider perspective. The course will provide participants with necessary theoretical background, practical experiences, concrete exercises and hands-on practice so that they develop an in-depth understanding of the key strategic issues involved in this area. The provisional agenda is placed at Annex 1 (a). This training will be conducted in English. 

It will also provide an opportunity for potential partners to make proposals to the Management Committee.
