**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Sub:-- Amendment in the Recruitment Rule of Junior Wireless Officers of WPC/WMO.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to say that the post of JE(W) one of the feeder cadre for promotion to the post of JWO, have been merged to JWO, on the recommendation of the 6<sup>th</sup> CPC. Therefore, the existing Recruitment Rules of JWO are required to be amended. The process for amendment in the RRs have been initiated. Tech. Grade I is also the feeder cadre for promotion to the post of JWO whose cadre controlling authority is Wireless Monitoring Organization. As per DoP&T's instructions, prior to moving the proposal for amendment of Recruitment Rule of JWO, the comments from the stakeholders may be obtained.

2. You are requested to circulate the same inviting suggestions / comments on the draft RRs and furnish the same for further necessary action.
