Broadband figures for July'22, June'22 & July'21 are 807.42 million, 800.94 million & 808.59 million respectively.

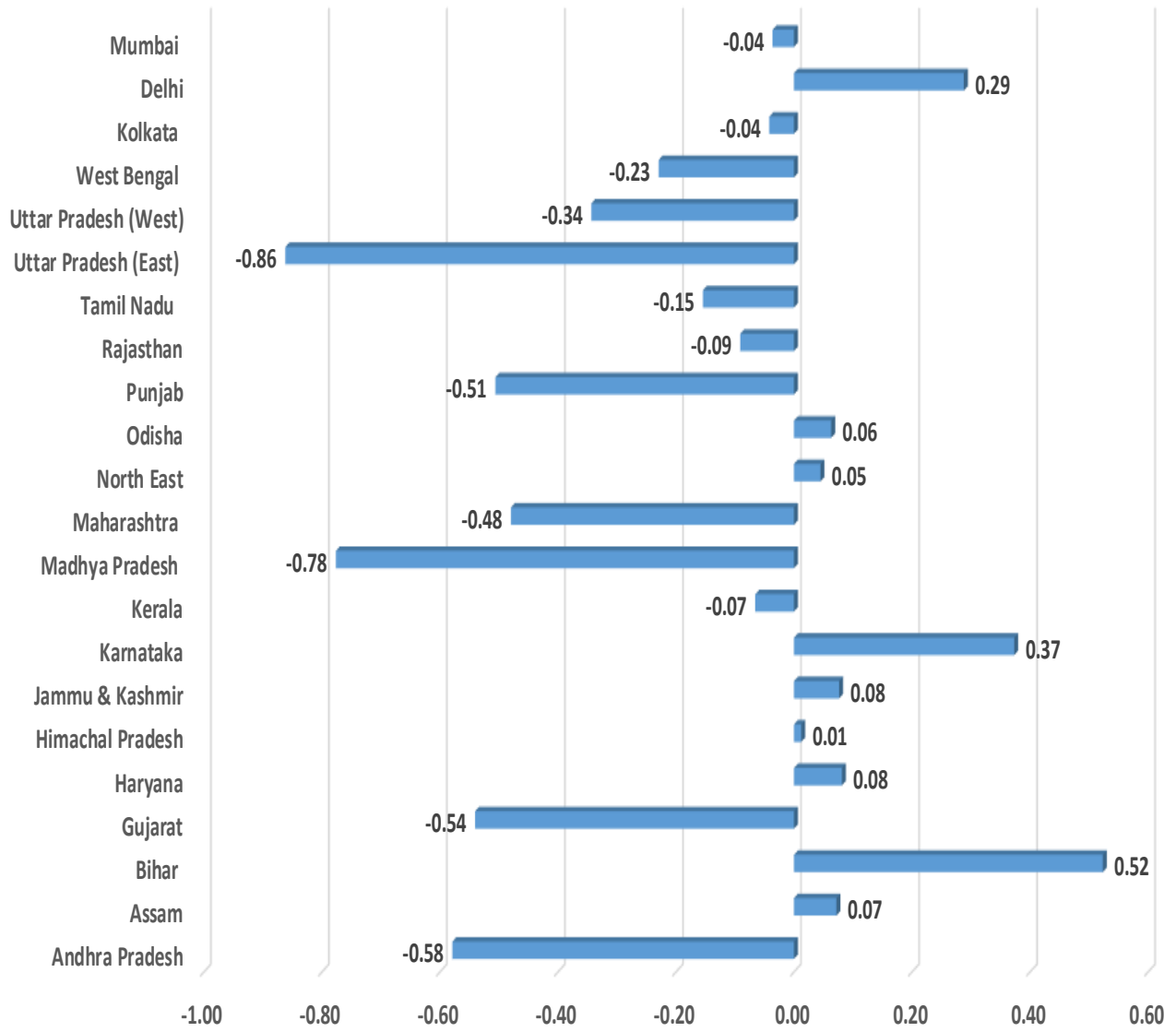


At the end of September'22, the total number of telephones was 1171.77 million, compared to 1174.94 million by the end of August'22, showing a decrease of 3.17 million.

☞ Maximum rise in total telephone connections was recorded in Bihar (523369) followed by Karnataka (373259) and Delhi (287903). However, Uttar Pradesh (East), Madhya Pradesh and Andhra Pradesh recorded a maximum fall in telephone connections over previous month.

Increase/Decrease from August'22 to September'22 (in million)





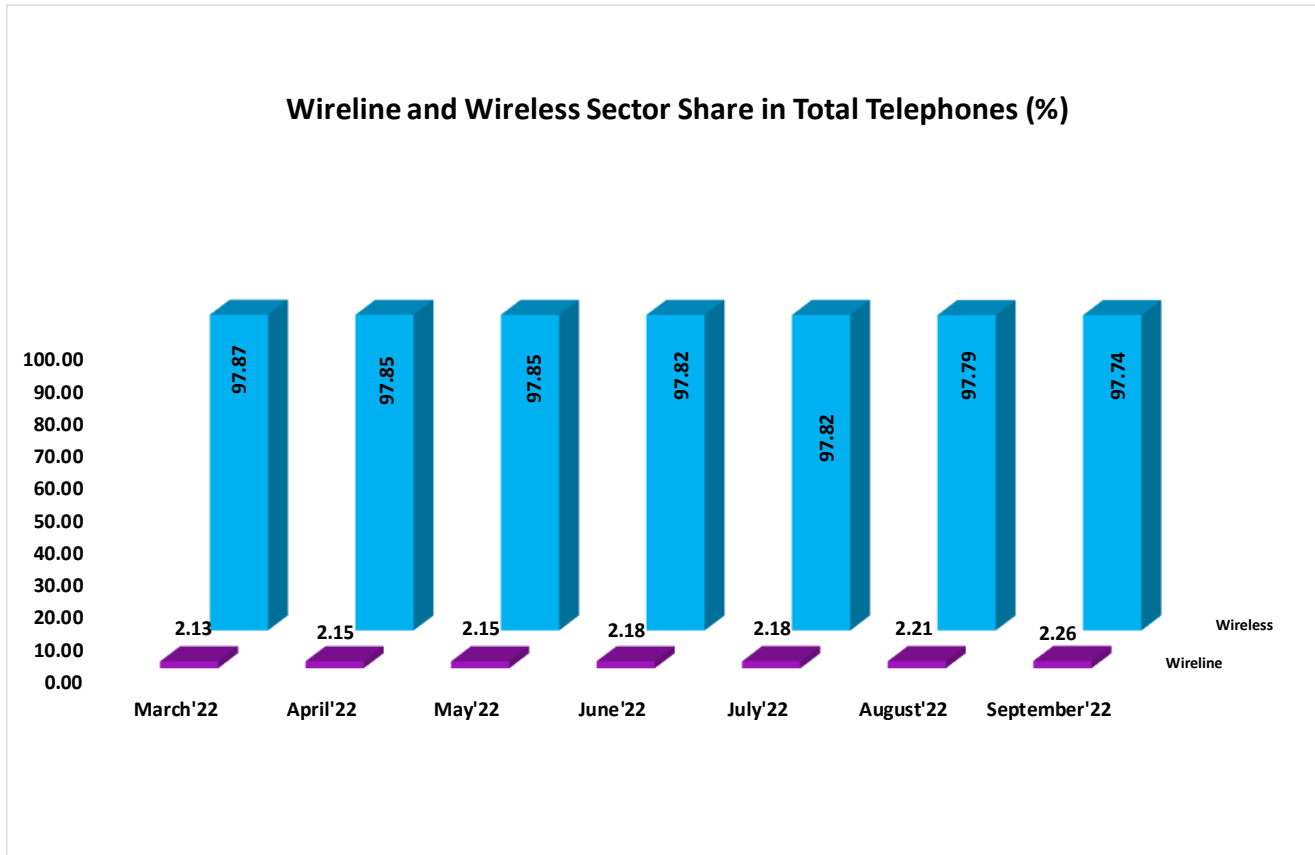
Service area-wise analysis reveals that Uttar Pradesh (East) had the highest share in the total telephones (8.66%) followed by Maharashtra (7.95%), Bihar (7.81%), Andhra Pradesh (7.24%) and Tamil Nadu (6.86%). These five Service areas taken together accounted for 38.51% of total telephone connections in India.

- The share of wireless segment in total connections stood at 97.74% by the end of September'22, while the share of wireline telephones was 2.26%.

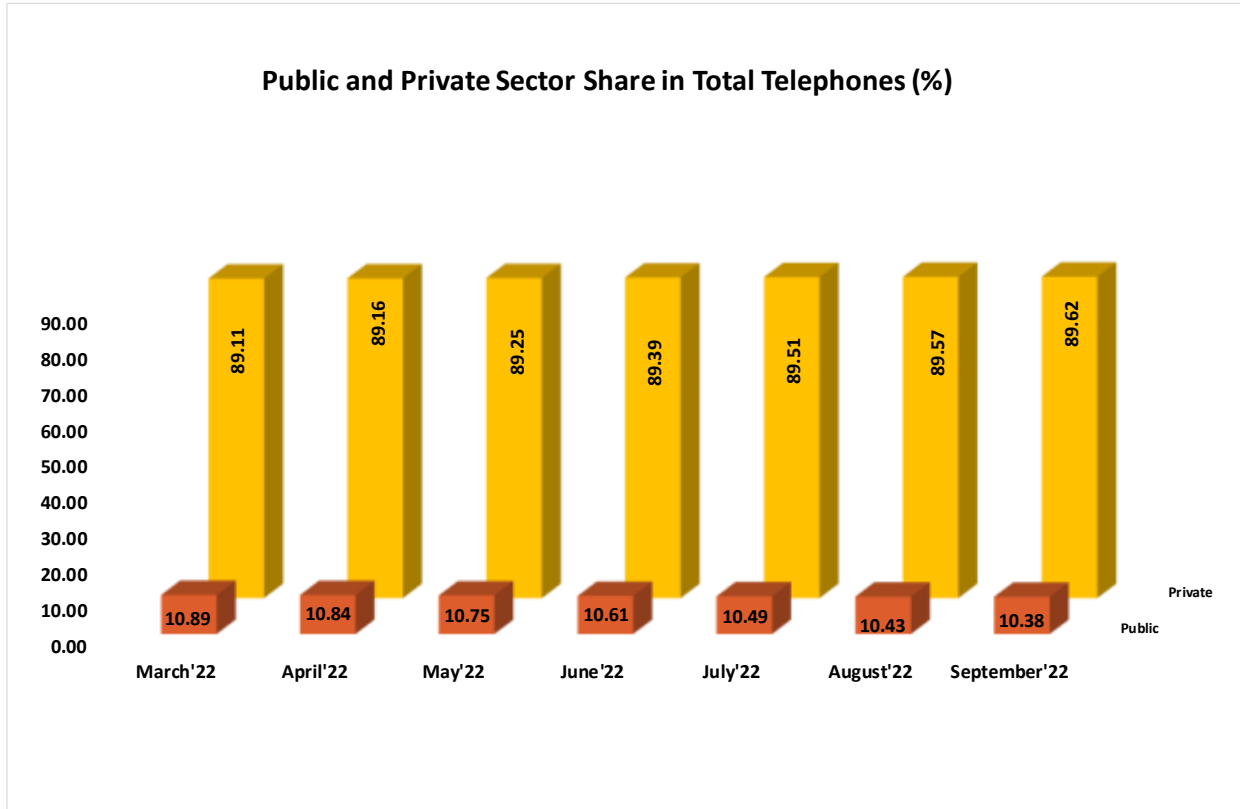

In September'22, share of public sector in total telephones was 10.38%, as against 89.62% of the private sector. In August'22, it was 10.43% and 89.57% respectively.

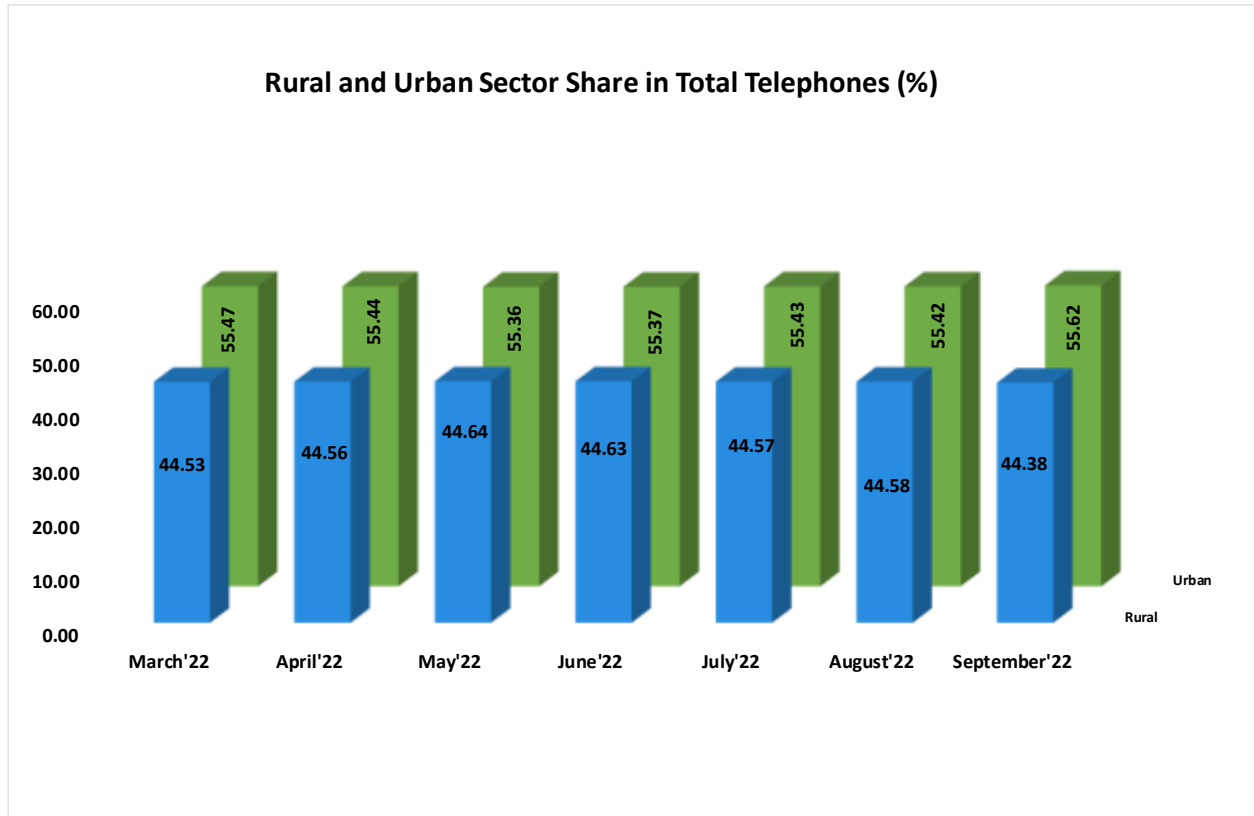

Teledensity

- ☞ The overall tele-density at the end of September'22 stood at 84.85% as against 85.14% in August'22. Among the Service areas, Himachal Pradesh (133.29%) had the highest tele-density followed by Kerala (123.02%), Punjab (115.66%), Tamil Nadu (102.49%) and Karnataka (101.71%). Among the three metros, Delhi Service Area topped in tele-density with 269.44%, followed by Kolkata (141.14%) and Mumbai (136.00%).

The teledensity for wireless segment was 82.94% whereas that of wireline segment is 1.91%. Teledensity reported in rural areas was 57.91% and that in the urban areas was 134.94%. In Public sector, teledensity was 8.81% and in Private sector, it was 76.04% for the month of September'22.

The number of Internet subscribers (both broadband and narrowband put together) which was 829.30 million at the end of December'21 decreased to 824.89 million by the end of March'22. The number of subscribers accessing internet via wireless phones was 797.61 million at the end of March'22. The number of wired Internet subscribers was 27.28 million at the end of March'22.
