**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject: Allotment of candidates to the various services/posts for appointment on the basis of the results of the Engineering Services Examination-2022 (Reserve List)**

The undersigned is directed to state that the Department of Telecommunications had circulated allocation lists of candidates for various services/posts vide its Office Memorandum No. 02-01/2022-Rectt(ESE) dated 12.06.2023. Subsequently, in pursuance of Rule 13 of the Engineering Services Examination Rules-2022, the Commission vide letter No. 1/4(14)/2022-E.VII dated 28.06.2023 has released a Reserve List of candidates belonging to Civil, Mechanical, Electrical and Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering disciplines.

2. Allocation of candidates has been done, keeping in view the provisions of the Engineering Services Examination Rules-2022, strictly on the basis of marks secured by the candidates, order of preferences for various services/posts exercised, medical requirements of various services and medical fitness of the candidates for services allotted and availability of vacancies in their category at their turn. The allotment list showing the allocation of candidates to various services/posts is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

3. Medical Reports of candidates and clearances in respect of candidature of candidates (Provisional/Conditional) received from UPSC have been placed in their respective dossiers.

4. Claim of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC) or Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) have been accepted by the Commission on the basis of the Original Certificates/ Income & Asset certificates (in case of EWS) submitted by them. Copies of these Certificates submitted by the candidates have been placed in their respective dossiers by the UPSC itself. In case of doubt regarding genuineness/ claim of the candidate regarding his/her community (ie. Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/ OBC) or Income & Asset certificates (in case of EWS), the Cadre Controlling Authorities/Participating Ministries may, if they consider it necessary, verify further the genuineness of these documents at their end. There may be some cases where though the OBC certificates have been issued to the candidates, the "Creamy Layer" status may be doubtful keeping in view the income/ status of the parents of the candidates as per declaration of the candidates vide column 11 in the Detailed Application Form. It is advised that participating Ministries may, in such cases, ensure that candidates do not attract "Creamy Layer" provision and offers of appointment to these candidates may be made after the Ministry/CCA concerned satisfies itself in this respect also.

5. Verification of character and antecedents in respect of the candidates indicated in **Annexure I** is to be done by the Cadre Controlling Authorities concerned to their satisfaction as stipulated in DOP&T's OM No. 13012/1/2007-AIS-I dated 27.06.2007 and 04.01.2008 and DOP&T's OM No. 18011/29s/2016-Estt.(B)(i) dated 29.06.2016. The cadre controlling Ministries / Departments are requested to obtain Attestation Forms from candidates allotted to services/posts under their control for the purpose of verification of their character and antecedents from the district Authorities concerned. Pending such verification participating Ministries are advised to inform candidates that offers of appointment issued are provisional subject to clearance from the Cadre Controlling Authority regarding completion of verification of their character and antecedents.

**6. Conditional Case:**

Candidature of one (01) candidate is still conditional due to reason as specified in **Annexure-III**. The said discrepancy may be resolved by the Cadre Controlling Authority. Offers of appointment to this candidate need not, however, be withheld on this account.

7. A total of 8 candidates of the Civil (4) and Electronics and Telecommunication (4) Disciplines could not be allotted to any service/post on account of non appearing for medical examination/medical unfitness/fitness for non-technical services as given in **Annexure-II**.
8. While issuing offers of appointment, detailed instructions as issued from time to time by Union Public Service Commission and DoP&T's instructions may be followed. In addition, clause relating to verification/ acceptance of caste certificates etc. may also please be incorporated in the appointment letters clearly bringing out that if at any stage it is found that any Certificate/Document/testimonial etc. as furnished by the candidate and having a bearing on his/her eligibility is not in order, his/her appointment shall be cancelled forthwith without prejudice to any punitive action under the relevant rules.
9. It is advised that arrangements for additional training and coaching to the candidates belonging to OBC candidates vide Commission's Order No. 3/06/2003-C.II dated 16.04.2004 so that they may come up to the standard of other direct recruits appointed along with them.
10. No departmental candidates under the age concession admissible to departmental candidates, has been recommended by the Commission.
11. UPSC may please be kept informed from time to time about the position of appointment of these candidates. Copies of offers of appointment as and when issued to them may please be endorsed to the UPSC and to this Department and the dates of joining of candidates may also be advised subsequently. Assessment reports on the work & performance of the candidates may be made available to the Commission every year for a period of 5 years subsequent to their appointments. Copies of the Gazette Notifications appointing the candidates to the service to which they have been allotted may also be sent to the UPSC is due course.
12. In case the candidates do not accept offer of appointments, their dossiers may please be returned to UPSC directly under intimation to this Office. A vacancy against which a candidate has been allotted is deemed to be filled up for all purposes. Replacement against such candidates will not be provided. It may please be noted that UPSC has from time to time reiterated that Reserve List is not a waiting list to cater to vacancies arising out of other reasons such as candidate not turning up to join, being found medically unfit, left out on account of medical fitness for limited services, resignation or any other reasons. Therefore, there are unfilled vacancies in some of the services due to candidates being absent for medical examination or being unfit for the services.
13. Name (exact spelling of name) of the allotted candidate may be verified from the dossiers of the candidate being forwarded and their Marks obtained may please be verified from the UPSC Mark list uploaded on Department of Telecommunications (DoT) website at link: <https://dot.gov.in/circular-and-notifications/3060> .
