The service provider / Licencee is hereby granted Wireless Operating License (WOL) to establish wireless network subject to the following:

- 1. The validity of this WOL is for a period of 5 years from the date of issue of this license which can be extended by further periods of up to 5 years at a time, subject to the remaining validity period of the assigned Spectrum. The Government reserves its right to curtail the granted spectrum or to rescind the license or to suitably enhance the charges relating to spectrum usage and possession of Wireless telegraphy Equipment.
- 2. The service shall be provided to the subscribers only in the area specified and within the technical parameters prescribed in the WOL and its schedules.

- 3. The Service Provider/ Licensee shall Indemnify the Government against all action, claims and demands, which may be brought or made by any person arising out of or connected with this WOL.
- 4. The Service Provider / Licensee shall abide by the terms and conditiions governing grant of licence to its subcribers / customers.
- 5. The Service Provider / Licensee shall not change the technical parameters of the wireless station from those specified in WOL without prior written approval of the Central Government.
- 6. An authorized officer of the Central Government may inspect the wireless station to verify that the said station operates as per technical parameters of WOL.
- 7. The Service Provider / Licensee shall submit estimated / ex-post quarterly statements (for quarter ending on 31st March, 30th June, 30th September, 31st December) of the Adjusted Gross revenue (AGR) dully supported by affidavits to Wireless Finance Division (WFD) of Department of Telecommunication (DOT), as also annual statement at end of financial year, as per instruction issued from time to time.
- 8. The Service Provider / Licensee shall furnish separate Financial Bank Guarntee (FBG) in accordance with the instruction issued from time to time by the Central Government for securing the recovery of dues which may occur on account of spectrum charges including roylty and license fee for possession of wireless telegraphy equipment.
- 9. The spectrum charges for the use of spectrum shall be paid by the The Service Provider / Licensee in accordance with the instructions issued from time to time by WPC Wing, DOT based on the Annual Gross Revenue submitted by the Service Provider / Licensee.
- 10. If the payements are not made in accordance with such instructions, the spectrum dues shall be recovered from the Financial Bank Guarantee and the Wireless Operating License shall be demmed to have been terminated on the expiry of the last day upto which The Service Provider / Licensee would have paid the spectrum charges along with penal interest. Further, no notice upon the The Service Provider / Licensee shall be served by the WPC Wing. DOT for termination of the Wireless Operating License for non payment of spectrum charges under this condition. However, the termination does not preclude The Service Provider / Licensee to apply afresh for the Wireless Operating License, subject to the payment of such charges / fees as may be decided by the WPC Wing.

- 11. (i) Licensee shall ensure that the Base Stations, Cell Sites or Radio Transmitters, as the case may be, to provide mobile telephone services near International Border of India, wherever located and established shall be as far away from such border as feasible and such base stations, Cell sites or Radio Transmitters shall work in such fashion that radio signal(s), emanating thereform, fade out when nearing or about to cross international border and become unusable within a reasonable distance across such border. For this purpose, suitable technical infrastructure shall be installed by the Licensee.
- 11. (ii) Notwithstanding anything in condition 11(i), in the areas falling within 10 Kms of Line of Control (LOC), Line of Actual Control (LAC) and International border between Akhnoor in J&K and Pathankot and other areas as may be notified from time to time by the Licensor, installation of Base Stations, Cell sites or Radio transmitters or any concerned equipment and execution of the concerned project by the Licensee shall be taken up only after prior approval from local Army authorities about specific location of BTS with prior intimation to the Licensor and concerned VTM Cell in addition to requisite clearance. The licensor, its authorized representative(s) as well as Army authorities, shall have powers to inspect such BTS(s) and the Licensee shall facilitate inspection of the BTS as per requisition from such authorities. During emegency, if so desired by the Licensor and / or Army, the licensee shall shut down BTS(s) under intimation to the Licensor / Concerned VTM Cell. The order for shutting down such BTS(s) by Army must be signed by at least Commanding Officer of local Army Unit.
- 12. The above terms and conditions are without prejudice to any other action that may be taken by the Government as per the terms and conditions in the main license agreement entered into by the service provider / Licensee with the DOT.
