

It is again requested that the arrangement mentioned therein may be continued for the year 2018 and subsequent years also, unless revised by this Department.

2. It is further informed that Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has approved the revised rates i.e. Rs. 2000/- for men and Rs. 2200/- for women may also be allowed to be reimbursed in respect of AIS Officers as is being reimbursed in case of Group 'A' officers of CCS.

The Chief Medical Superintendents of the approved Government and private hospitals are therefore, requested to kindly ensure that the system works smoothly and the individual officer does not face any inconvenience. All the prescribed tests may please be conducted on a single day and the report provided to the officers concerned on the next day.
