I am directed to refer to this office order of even number dated 28.02.2018 vide which transfer/posting order dated 20.12.2017 of unabsorbed SDEs/JTOs was kept in abeyance and to say that though the transfer/posting order has been kept in abeyance, **Shri D.D. Shah, JTO, who is BSNL optee** but facing disciplinary proceedings has been relieved by AGM (EB) O/o PGMTD, Rajkot vide order No. RJ/EB/Staff-General/2017-18 dated 31.03.2018 for posting in LSA-Ahmedabad. A representation dated 13.01.2018 of Shri D. D. Shah was received in this office in this regard wherein he requested for retention in BSNL for above-mentioned reasons and health problems and his retirement within two years.

- 2. The relieving order dated 31.03.2018 issued by PGTMD, Rajkot is quite bad as the fact that Shri D.D Shah, JTO is BSNL optee and is facing disciplinary proceedings has not been considered. Besides, orders of transfer/posting are non operative as on date and therefore, BSNL, Rajkot should not have relieved the above-officer by ignoring the factum of the case. Accordingly, relieving order dated 31.03.2018 of Shri D.D. Shah is declared void.
- 3. It is requested that necessary corrective measures may be taken in instant matter and compliance may be sent to this office by 30-04-2018.
